Dr. Pirelli is 1 of just 6 people **Board Certified in Forensic Psychology** (ABPP) based out of New Jersey and 1 of 300 or so, nationally. He is a **Fellow** of the American Academy of Forensic Psychology (AAFP). He received his Ph.D. from The Graduate Center at John Jay College of Criminal Justice, and is a Licensed Psychologist in three (3) states: New Jersey (#4975), New York (#019418), and Pennsylvania (#018980). His experience includes working in numerous inpatient and outpatient settings, including hospitals, psychiatric centers, and correctional facilities. Specifically, he trained and worked in over a dozen settings even *prior* to entering full-time private practice, incl. hospital/inpatient, outpatient, forensic/inpatient, and corrections, and has since worked in many additional settings for cases at the **county, state and federal levels**. Of note, Dr. Pirelli has conducted evaluations in matters from **all 21 NJ counties**, in addition to numerous states (e.g., NJ, NY, PA, RI, & CA). Namely, Dr. Pirelli has conducted **1,500+ evaluations**, has overseen 1,000 more, and **testified 125+ times** - and **qualified 100% of the time he has been called to the stand as an expert**.

Dr. Pirelli leads the group practice, **Pirelli Clinical and Forensic Psychology, LLC**, whereby he conducts evaluations in criminal, civil, and administrative matters, including but not limited to:

- Criminal:** -Insanity, Dim. Capacity/Mens Rea (Mental State at time of Offense/Crim Responsibility)
-Criminal Competencies (e.g., Fitness to Proceed, *Miranda* waiver)
-Risk Assessment, Diversion, and Mitigation Evaluations (Pre-Trial & Sentencing)
- Civil:** -Emotional Distress Evaluations
-Personal Injury and Medical Malpractice
-Employment Harassment, Discrimination, Wrongful Termination
- Admin:** -Firearm Evaluations (FPIC, CCW, forfeiture/reinstatement, “Red Flag” TERPO/FERPO)
-Mental Health Expungements

Dr. Pirelli has taught over 40 post-doctoral, graduate, and undergraduate courses at John Jay College of Criminal Justice, Fairleigh Dickinson U., and Montclair State U. In addition, he was the Editor of the state journal, *New Jersey Psychologist*, and has been on the editorial board and reviewed for numerous leading journals.

Dr. Pirelli has given professional conference presentations, invited talks, trainings and CE/CLE workshops to a range of professional groups. He also has an extensive clinical-forensic research publication record, which includes **being the lead on three (3) books with Oxford University Press**: *The Ethical Practice of Forensic Psychology: A Casebook* (2017), *The Behavioral Science of Firearms: A Mental Health Perspective on Guns, Suicide, and Violence* (2018), and *Firearms and Clinical Practice: A Handbook for Medical and Mental Health Professionals* (2023), as well as chapters in such books as the *Handbook of Forensic Psychology (4th Edition)*, *Violent Offenders: Understanding and Assessment*, and *Psychology in the Courtroom*.

Dr. Pirelli was awarded the **2024 Lawrence S. Wrightsman Book Award** by AP-LS/Div. 41 of APA, for his book, *Firearms and Clinical Practice* (1 of only 14 books in 25 years), and his research has been cited over 600 times in the professional literature, as well as in amicus briefs to the **United States Supreme Court (SCOTUS)** and the **New York Court of Appeals**, as well as in the **United States Department of Justice (DOJ) President’s Commission on Law Enforcement and the Administration of Justice** final report (2020).
